Check your credit and debit cards statements routinely to verify all activity



Protect your credit and debit cards numbers from third-parties

Use trusted vendors and their apps, rather than a link



Watch out for new or unfamiliar retailers that offer deals that are "too good to be true"



Look for https:// (not http) in the address bar before using your credit card online



Keep your anti-virus/malware/firewall software up-to-date
